



## Derek Daly inducted into Sebring Hall of Fame



We are all very proud of our boss, Derek Daly, who was inducted into the **Sebring Hall of Fame** on Friday March 18th 2010. Derek won the Sebring 12 hour endurance race twice in 1990 & 1991 driving for the factory Nissan team. Sebring is arguably the most significant endurance race in America with past winners including, Mario Andretti and Bobby Rahal.

After retiring from competition in 1992, Derek concentrated on television broadcasting with ESPN and Speed Channel. Derek was

nominated by ESPN for a cable ACE award in his first year with the network.

The induction ceremony took place at the Chateau Elan Four Points Sheraton which is located at the hairpin turn of the historic venue. During Derek's acceptance speech he became mildly distracted by the Formula Star Mazda race that was taking place at the same time because he could see through the window that the race was being led by his 18 year old son, Conor. Derek gave what was described later that night at a gala dinner, "*the best acceptance speech ever at the induction ceremonies*". Derek's son Conor finished on the podium in 3rd place.
